# APPOINTMENT BOOK

## Executive Summary

At the February 2020 Midyear Meeting, the AOA Board of Trustees approved the reorganization of the AOA’s existing governance structure. Bureaus, Councils and Committees (B/C/Cs), including several task forces, were reduced from 52 entities to 28 entities. The functions and roles each of the 52 previous entities retained have been preserved in the new reorganized governance structure, with the exception of a small number that were always expected to conclude their work upon completion of the transition to the Single GME Accreditation System (June 30, 2020). Some B/C/Cs with redundant structure have been retained and are accommodated under B/C/Cs within the new structure to improve efficiency.

The newly reorganized governance structure and appointment process was designed to streamline decision making, reduce conflict in decision making and communication, and reduce operational expense. The 2020-2021 appointment process concluded with President Thomas L. Ely, DO making over 250 appointments to various positions within the new governance structure with the final approval of the 2020-2021 AOA Board of Trustees.
