For the 2022-24 certification CME cycle, all AOA board-certified diplomates are required to meet the CME requirement(s) of their specialty certifying board(s) as listed in the table below. Please note the listed requirements are for the sole purpose of AOA Board Certification only. It is the responsibility of the individual physician to stay informed of their CME requirements for state licensure, membership in other organizations, etc.
